Confession of Sin: *Unison Prayer* Pastor Jim Urish

Father, we have sinned.

We confess that we do not listen to your Word. We read it and hear it, but we do not obey it.

We confess that we do not worship you the way you commanded us to worship you. We are more concerned about what we get out of it than what we put it into it. We are often distracted. Our lips keep moving, but our hearts are cold and still.

We confess that we do not love one another very much.

We confess that we do not always fulfill our responsibilities to one another. We are harsh when we should be gentle, and when we need to be firm, we lack the courage to say or do what is right.

We confess we try to be as worldly as we think we can get away with. We prefer to squeeze our faith in around the edges of life, rather than to let you stand at the center to control everything we are and have.

We confess we lack the courage to proclaim the gospel. We are afraid to talk about spiritual things, for fear of what others will think.

We confess that we lack compassion. We have not loved our neighbor as we are commanded.

In the name of Jesus, we ask forgiveness for these and all our sin.
